5.01 REGISTRATION

All electors in the Town of Center shall be registered and the Town Clerk shall administer elector registration pursuant to Chapter 6 of the Wisconsin State Statutes.

5.02 SPECIAL REGISTRATION DEPUTIES

The Town Clerk shall administer elector registration in accordance with Wis. Stats. Sec 6.26 to be appointed as a special registration deputy for the purpose of registering electors prior to the close of registration and Wis. Stats. Sec 6.55 for polling place registration.

5.03 APPOINTMENT OF ELECTION OFFICIALS

The Town Clerk shall have the authority and discretion to determine the number of election officials necessary for each election, but not less than three (3) per polling place, and,

The Town Clerk shall have the authority and discretion to divide the election workers appointed by the town board into not more than two (2) sets, with an equal number of alternates per set and the election officials are to work at different times on Election Day as necessary, and

The Town Clerk shall have the authority to appoint one additional inspector to serve at each polling place without regard to party affiliation who shall serve as a greeter to answer questions and to direct electors to the proper locations for registration and voting and who shall be available to substitute for other election officials who must leave the room during the voting process.
