ALARM SYSTEM/FALSE ALARM RESPONSE FEES

- 17.01 Definitions
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17.01 DEFINITIONS

- (1) Alarm systems are such electronic systems installed in any buildings to monitor any of the following: temperature, smoke, heat, water flow and/or access.
- (2) Alarm systems may be monitor by the occupants or by an outside monitoring agency.
- (3) An occupant, passerby, law enforcement, and/or an alarm company can report a false report of an alarm as considered here.
- (4) A false alarm incident is considered anytime an emergency service is dispatched without a need even if canceled in route.
- (5) Frequency of alarm shall be the number of alarms in the last 12 months, 365 days.

17.02 ALARM FREQUENCY

Notice of Violation shall be give after 3 false alarms in the last 12 months.

17.03 NOTICES OF VIOLATION

Notice of Violation shall be given in writing by registered mail or in person with a wittiness' to the owner, lessee, manager, or assistant manager and include a copy of this chapter.

17.20 PENALTIES

For the 4th thru 6th false run in a 12-month period the charge of \$500 for each incident shall be forfeited. For the 7th and forward false run in a 12-month period the charge of \$1000 for each incident shall be forfeited. If these forfeiters are not paid, they shall be added to the tax bill as a special assessment.
